



## SAFE PLAY GUIDELINES

### **Chesterfield Petanque Club commencing May 17**

All members

A Maximum of 20 members are allowed to play petanque on the piste at any one time

Only four 2 metre wide separate petanque playing lanes (evenly spaced across the piste) to be used for play. At the side of each playing lane a 2 metre wide lane must be kept vacant (the non play lane) to allow space for adequate social distancing.

As stated in previous safe guide play guidelines, player should only use their own playing equipment and not touch other player's playing items.

No congregating in groups while playing – only one person should measure any boules ideally one person on each team should throw the cosh which must be their own personal cosh.

At all times social distancing ideally of 2 metres should take place.

Whenever not playing and also at the start and the finish of play again social distancing must be adhered to.

At the start of each playing session there should be no congregating in groups and social distancing by all members should be adhered to.

All players should leave the piste at the end of play without congregating and again social distancing measures should be in adhered to.

A register of the full names of each player should be kept at each playing session for track and trace purposes and each person must give this information before start of each playing session.
